A1	<p>As per the documents, there is a mention of Reference ID No. in most of the forms but in the documents nowhere Reference ID No. has been given, please provide the same.</p> <p>Answer:- ITA, Clause 1.1 states that the identification reference number, if any, is provided in the PDS. There is no identification number stated in the PDS</p>
A2	<p>Please confirm the rate of US\$ to be considered for the purpose of conversion of INR & Euro Currency.</p> <p>Answer:- The applicant should state the exchange rate and date. The date should be within 28 days of the date of application.</p>
A3	<p>Joint Venture Format has not been provided in the documents. Is there any specific format or we can use our format, as per practice.</p> <p>Answer:- The JVA letter of intent or existing agreement shall conform to the requirements of ITA, Clause 4.1</p>
B1	<p>Page III – 4, 4.2(a) Specific Construction Experience Regarding required documents to be submitted, would you kindly tell us whether completion certificate of each project is required or not?</p> <p>Answer:- A copy of the completion certificate is required.</p>
B2	<p>Page III – 5, 4.2(b) Specific Construction Experience Regarding requirement, would you kindly explain further about "concrete production per month"?</p> <p>Answer:- The average concrete production over the contract period should meet the specified requirement</p>
B3	<p>Page IV – 10, 4.2(a) Specific Construction Experience Regarding "Amount", would you kindly explain it in more details of what exactly to fill?</p> <p>Answer:- The amount should be the value in US \$. Delete the wording "<i>insert full name</i>" under "Amount"</p>
B4	<p>Page IV – 10, Form EXP - 4.2(a) Specific Construction Experience Regarding "Complexity", would you kindly explain it in more details of what exactly to fill? Does it mean component such as intake facility or sand basin, or does it mean scope of work such as design, manufacture, install, supply or training of personnel?</p> <p>Answer:- The complexity should include details of the works constructed and the scope of the work covered by the contract i.e. design, manufacture, install, supply or training of</p>

	personnel
B5	<p>Page IV – 10, Form EXP - 4.2(a) Specific Construction Experience Regarding "Methods/Technology", would you kindly explain it in more details of what exactly to fill? Does it mean method of treatment such as rapid filtration method?</p> <p>Answer:- This should include the methods/ technology used during construction e.g. concrete pumping, climbing formwork, micro-tunnelling etc together with any other contract specific requirements.</p>
C1	<p>Page III – 3, Eligibility and Qualification Criteria. This is normal practice followed in India for various National & International Funded Projects that for calculating the Average Turnover the <u>Adjustment Factors</u> to bring the same to the current year are considered. From the Tender abstract of recent ADB Tender Pre- Qualification(Attached); you will kindly note that not only the adjustment factors to estimate the equivalent year 2011 has been allowed , but also the Average of LAST THREE YEARS is to be considered; whereas the experience of Last 10 years is to be considered. In view of the above kindly confirm the following :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1 Kindly confirm the updating factor for the last 5 years,2 Is it possible to consider the each partners eligibility to be for 15% instead 25% specified by you.3 Kindly allow to take an average of 3 years instead of 5 years. <p>Answer:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1 The project is being carried out under JICA ODA Loan and, therefore, ADB requirements are not applicable.2 The eligibility will be as specified in the document – 25 percent.3 The average will be as specified in the document – 5 years
